

Seven Sacred Teachings Award



The Seven Sacred Teachings Award recognizes Youth aged 15-29 from the AETS member communities who in the past year have demonstrated the Seven Sacred Teachings in whole or in part (Love, Honesty, Truth, Courage, Wisdom, Humility and/or Respect). Through their actions, nominees are improving the quality of life or well-being of others. The award is honorary and recognizes Youth with a certificate and a plaque.

Eligible award nominees are:

- Youth aged 15-29 as a single recipient or group. (Under exceptional circumstances youth under 15 years of age may be considered)
- Citizens or affiliates of the AETS communities
- Addressing the health, social and/or economic challenges, improving the quality of life or well-being of others
- Demonstrating the Seven Sacred Teachings in whole or in part through their actions



The nominees' contribution to others, the challenge(s) faced and how the nominees are inspiring others are among the factors considered in this award.
