



A to Z Truck Driver

200 Hour Program

Program Info

This Ministry of Transportation approved course combines 200 hours of classroom time with hands-on training. Graduates of this program can find themselves employed as short haul, long haul, local pick-up and delivery, shunt drivers, driver trainers, driver supervisors and managers, tow truck drivers, transporting heavy equipment and/or as owners/operators.

Program Delivery

This program is delivered in five modules and the majority of the modules involve "seat time" where the students apply theory.

- Module one: A-Z manuals and air brake endorsement
- Module two: Yard demonstration and practice
- Module three: Trailer manoeuvre demonstration and practice
- Module four: Road demonstration and practice
- Module five: Professionalism

Program Evaluation

Students will be evaluated with 2 written and practical road tests, both "A" and "Z".

Program Certification

Graduates will receive their A-Z license, which includes the "Z" air break endorsement certification.

Admission Requirements

All candidates must have a Driver's Abstract, completion of MTO medical and Class G driver's licence.
