This exciting initiative, first launched in February 2013, was a pilot leadership development program for Aboriginal youth. Today, with 38 graduates and community partners, the program builds capacity among Aboriginal Youth aged 19-29 through an opening retreat, learning days, and a graduation. The program will be delivered within the framework of the Seven Grandfather Teachings as well as teachings from the Medicine Wheel, contributing to participant's cultural, spiritual, mental, physical and emotional wellbeing. This highly interactive initiative will prepare young people to move into positions of influence within government, education, skilled trades and more.

Sponsorship donations will help support Aboriginal Youth in a variety of ways: providing professional development to future decision makers and restoring teachings that were once lost to return youth to a path of leadership.
