Anishinabek Employment and Training Services is pleased to offer the Food Service Worker (FSW) Certificate program, including an 8 day Life Skills program starting May 30, 2022 followed by an 8 week and two day in person FSW program starting June 9, 2022 as well as up to an 8 week paid work placement starting August 8, 2022. Food Service Workers (FSW) assist with food preparation, and safe food handling for many avenues of the food industry.

Admission Requirements:

- 19 years of age or older
 - Full double Covid-19 Vaccination
 - Ontario Secondary School Diploma (or equivalent) with Grade 12 English (E/C/U) Level.
- OR**
- Successful completion of the Mature Student Testing or General Education Development Test (GED).
- OR**
- Appropriate credits from the Academic and Career Entrance (ACE) program - LBS level 5 Communication and LBS level 4 Mathematics.

Training Includes:

- 8 weeks training with 2 days kitchen labs
- Communication and the Food Service Worker
- Institutional Food Service
- Sanitation and Safety
- Intro to Nutrition
- Nutrition in Health Care
- Quantity Food Preparation

Program Includes:

- Safe Food Handling Certificate
- WHIMIS Certificate
- Certificate of Recognition and Completion from Confederation College
