Students will learn how to make a birch bark harvesting or wild rice basket as well as learn the traditional ways of harvesting birch bark in Pukaskwa National Park.

Fishing and Fish Hide Tanning

June 12 - 16, 2023

In partnership with Biigtigong Nishnaabeg First Nation

Students will go rod fishing on Lake Superior and enjoy a shore lunch. Also, students will learn how to hide fish skins.
