Moose Camp

Attend a community moose camp and learn how to track, hunt, and practice responsible hunting. Gain skills in wilderness navigation, tracking, hunting strategies and wildlife conservation.

Students will take part in ceremony teachings and learn from elders.

Fish-Hide Tanning

Learn the traditional skill of transforming fish skins into water resistant leather. This hands on activity will help master the art of preparing, tanning, and finishing fish hides using time-honored techniques. Students will be given the tools to carry on this traditional knowledge.

This activity explores the history of the distinct Indigenous art style, blending traditional legends and myths with contemporary mediums.

Students will harness artistic creativity as they create their own Woodland art.
