- 19 years of age or older

- Ontario Secondary School Diploma (or equivalent) with Grade 12 English (E/C/ U) Level.

OR

 Successful completion of the Mature Student Testing or Gederal Education Development Test (GED).

OR

 Appropriate credits from the Academic and Career Entrance (ACE) program – LBS level 5 Communication and LBS level 4 Mathematics.

- Sanitation and Safety
- Intro to Nutrition
