AETS, in partnership with Confederation College, is offering a 22-week condensed Pre-Health Sciences Pathways to Certificates and Diplomas Program staring September 13, 2021. The 2-week Life Skills component will be completed in person (as allowed), followed by 20-weeks of virtual training with Confederation College. The Pathways to Certificates and Diplomas program is for students who want to go to College Health programs such as Practical Nursing, Paramedic and Dental Hygiene. Topics covered include Pre-Health Math, Health Care in Canada, Chemistry, Introductory Biology, and Communications for Health Professionals and 1 General Elective, will support exemption of these courses in Practical Nursing or other Health fields of study at Confederation College.

Program Requirements:

- Ontario Secondary School Diploma (or equivalent) with courses from the College (C), University (U), University/College (U/C), or Open (O) preparation levels with Grade 12 English (C/U) level
- Or successful completion of the Mature Student Assessment
- Or successful completion of the General Education Development Test (GED)
- Or appropriate credit from the Academic and Career Entrance Program (ACE)

Program Consists of:

2 weeks Life Skills

20 weeks of classes
