There will be minimal disruption of services and programs to the nine member First Nations, Job Seeker Clients and Employer Clients. AETS is planning to open at their new address by June 2nd, 2025, on the third floor of 523 Algoma Street North, Box 4, Thunder Bay, Ontario, P7A 5C2 and will continue to offer services and programs in Suite 210 at 250 Park Avenue within Goods & Co in the former Eaton's Building. Please note that AETS can accommodate meetings by appointment only. No Walk-Ins until further notice. More information will be forthcoming.
