

Anishinabek Employment and Training Services (AETS) in cooperation with the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities, Northstar Training Centre and Superior Strategies, have initiated a new program which involves Aboriginal participants completing a Pre-Apprenticeship Training Program (PATP) in the Level 1 Construction Craft Worker (450A) trade with the intention that upon completion of the program, all participants will become registered apprentices, gain employment in the sector or enter related post-secondary training.
