

Event Synopsis: Mining Indigenous Workforce Development Roundtable (MIWDR)

The Mining Indigenous Workforce Development Roundtable (MIWDR) is a collaborative, one-day event designed to unite key stakeholders in Ontario's mining sector. Organized by the Mining Industry Human Resources Council (MiHR) and Anishinabek Employment and Training Services (AETS), MIWDR will bring together representatives from Indigenous Skills and Employment Training Programs (ISETs), the mineral exploration and mining industries, post-secondary institutions, various levels of government and workforce development agencies to foster dialogue, partnerships and strategies for supporting Indigenous workforce development in Ontario's mining industry.

Objectives:

- Analyze current and future labour market trends in Ontario's mining sector.
- Showcase programs and services that help attract, recruit, and develop a diverse and sustainable talent pipeline.
- Encourage collaboration among stakeholders to advance Indigenous workforce development initiatives.
- Share best practices and innovative resources to inspire Indigenous youth to pursue careers in mining.

Event Highlights:

- Keynote presentations and a panel discussion featuring industry experts and thought leaders.
- Breakout sessions focusing on career awareness and workforce development, highlighting existing tools and resources.
- Networking opportunities for stakeholders to connect and build partnerships.
- A final report summarizing event discussions and recommendations for future strategies.

The MIWDR will host up to 100 participants in a dynamic setting that supports speaker sessions, interactive discussions and networking – representing a vital opportunity to collaboratively shape the future of Ontario's mining sector by focusing on sustainable and inclusive workforce development.
