Certified instructors from Confederation College's Natural Resources Centre, Workplace Safety North and FP Innovations will offer an interesting variety of instruction in topics directly related to sawmill economic development plans. The 20 weeks of this program consist of 12 weeks in class and 8 weeks of work placement. This program has a unique flexible design as it's delivered in modules of learning, containing specialized training blocks that can be timetabled in a way that suits the community, participants, and instructors.

Program Certification

The program instructors are qualified to certify participants in the specific learning modules of the course. The four modules are:

- Module one: Introduction to Wood Products Industry
- Module two: Safety First
- Module three: Mill Processes
