



BASIC LINE CUTTING (5 WEEK PROGRAM)

PROGRAM INFO:

This 5 week program offers a wide variety of rewarding opportunities. With Basic Line Cutting the participant begins to discover the skills and knowledge necessary to prepare for immediate employment or post-secondary education in the energy, mining or forestry sectors. It also provides a skill that is in high demand in the remote areas of Northwestern Ontario.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

The objective of the program is to recruit First Nations students to train for entry level jobs in the energy, forestry and mining sectors. The content of the course provides a good basic skill set in order to move into a career in these areas. The curriculum was developed in cooperation with the Ministry of Northern Development and Mines and representatives from the private sector.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

All potential students must have a minimum of a Grade 10 education, must be older than 18 years of age and must fill out all appropriate application forms and assessments prior to training.

COURSE INFORMATION:

This course will run from Monday to Friday – 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. – for 5 weeks. The course is divided into two portions, theory for 10 days and then fieldwork/practical for 14 days. Students will be provided with all personal protective equipment (PPE).

EVALUATION:

Students will be evaluated at the end of each section. The instructor will provide an opportunity for improvement based on this feedback. Specific tests will be administered in WHMIS, First Aid and Chainsaw Training. A customized handwritten test will be completed at the end of the program to determine if competencies are completed. A practical test will also be given in the field to determine the application of these competencies. Students must meet attendance requirements.

CREDENTIALS:

At the successful completion of the program, participants will receive a Confederation College “Recognition of Completion.”
