



PRE-TRADES CARPENTRY PROGRAM

(20 WEEK PROGRAM)

PROGRAM INFO:

Confederation College’s Pre-Trades training program prepares individuals for an apprenticeship opportunity. This training program is 20 weeks in duration and consists of two components:

- 1) Trades Readiness (12 weeks) which includes Academic Preparation in mathematics, communications, employability and computer skills, Introduction to Trades and Trades Preparation;
- 2) In-School Level 1 Apprenticeship (8 weeks) provides the learners with the foundation skills and knowledge to begin their career in the skilled trades which adheres to performance standards for training competencies and guidelines of the Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills Development.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

Trades Readiness (2 weeks)

1. Academic Preparation	240 hours
2. Trades Preparation	120 hours
Total	360 hours

Level I In-School Training (8 weeks)

1. Safety, Materials & Tools	168 hours
2. Plans, Specifications & Codes	24 hours
3. Residential -Estimating, Calculation & Layout	32 hours
4. Metal Cutting & Welding	15 hours
Total	240 hours

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

All potential students must have a minimum of a Grade 10 education, must be 18 years of age or older and must fill out all the appropriate application forms and assessments prior to training.

COURSE INFORMATION:

This course will run from Monday to Friday - 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. – for 20 weeks. Students will be provided with all personal protective equipment (PPE).

EVALUATION:

Students will be evaluated at the end of each section. Individual instructors will discuss evaluation procedures in their respective subject areas. Specific tests will be administered in WHMIS, First Aid, Hoisting and Rigging and Working at Heights. Students must meet attendance requirements.

Grades for the Trades Readiness will be a credit or non credit. Grades for the Level 1 In-School component of the program will be reported on a student’s academic transcript with an academic grade.

CREDENTIALS:

At the successful completion of the program, participants will receive a Confederation College “Recognition of Achievement”
