

CHAINSAW OPERATION AND SAFETY COURSE (ONE WEEK PROGRAM)

PROGRAM INFO:

This one week program offers a solid understanding of chainsaw operation and safety and could lead to a wide variety of rewarding opportunities. With Chainsaw Operation and Safety the participant learns how to safely operate and maintain chainsaws, a skill needed in the energy, mining or forestry sectors. It also provides a skill that is in high demand in the remote areas of Northwestern Ontario.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

The content of the course provides a good basic skill set in order to move toward other training opportunities, such as Line Cutting which is a necessary qualification for a career in the energy, forestry and mining sectors.

Modules

- Safety equipment
- Safe chainsaw handling
- Tree cutting techniques
- Forestry awareness
- Chainsaw maintenance

EVALUATION:

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

All potential students must have a minimum of a Grade 10 education, must be older than 18 years of age and must fill out all appropriate application forms and assessments prior to training.

COURSE INFORMATION:

This course will run from Monday to Friday – 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. – for one week. Students will be provided with all personal protective equipment (PPE).

Students will be evaluated at the end of each section. The instructor will provide an opportunity for improvement based on this feedback. A customized handwritten test will be completed at the end of the program to determine if competencies are completed. A practical test will also be given in the field to determine the application of these competencies. Students must meet attendance requirements.

At the successful completion of the program, participants will receive a Confederation College "Recognition of Completion."
