



# APPLIED ENVIRONMENTAL TECHNIQUES

## (15 WEEK PROGRAM)

### PROGRAM INFO:

**Confederation College's training program provides students with an introduction to the environmental sector. It emphasizes the key areas, environmental monitoring, environmental site assessments and contaminated sites remediation. Using the BEAHR curriculum this training program is 15 weeks in duration.**

### PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

Students will gain valuable experience through both in class and field activities, and will learn about sampling, testing, interpretation and evaluation of data, preparing reports, regulatory implications, and remedial action plans.

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

All potential students must have a minimum of a Grade 10 education, must be 18 years of age or older and must fill out all of the appropriate application forms and assessments prior to training.

### COURSE INFORMATION:

This course will run from Monday to Friday – 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. – for 15 weeks. Students will be provided with all personal protective equipment (PPE).

### EVALUATION:

Students will be evaluated at the end of each section. Individual instructors will discuss evaluation procedures in their respective subject areas. Specific tests will be administered and students must meet attendance requirements. Grades from this program will be reported on the student academic transcript.
