



HEAVY EQUIPMENT OPERATOR PROGRAM

(8 WEEK PROGRAM)

PROGRAM INFO:

Confederation College's Pre-Trades training program prepares individuals for employment in energy, forestry, mining and municipality sectors. This training program is 8 weeks in duration and consists of two components:

- 1) Trades Readiness (2 weeks) which includes Safety Training and Introduction to Machine Operation and Maintenance.
- 2) Machine Operation (6 weeks) which includes the operation of three pieces of heavy equipment (excavator, bulldozer and front end loader).

PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

All potential students must have a minimum of a Grade 10 education, must be 18 years of age or older and must fill out all of the appropriate application forms and assessments prior to training

COURSE INFORMATION:

This course will run from Monday to Friday – 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. – for 8 weeks. Students will be provided with all personal protective equipment (PPE).

EVALUATION:

Students will be evaluated at the end of each section. Individual instructors will discuss evaluation procedures in their respective subject areas. Specific tests will be administered in WHMIS, First Aid and Common Core. Students must meet attendance requirements.

Grades for the Trades Readiness and Machine Operation will be a credit or non credit.

CREDENTIALS:

At the successful completion of the program, participants will receive a Confederation College "Recognition of Achievement."
