

REMOTE CAMP SUPPORT WORKER

(6 WEEK PROGRAM)

PROGRAM INFO:

This 6 week program offers a wide variety of rewarding opportunities. The Remote Camp Support Worker program is designed to provide the trainee with the knowledge and skills to effectively support and assist the Camp Manager with daily duties including cook preparation, cleaning, serving, customer service and maintenance.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

This program provides the basic knowledge and skills required for any entry-level position in a remote camp location.

Topics Include:

- 1. Safe Food Handling
- 2. WHMIS
- 3. First Aid Training
- 4. Smart Serve Training
- 5. Customer Service (check in/check out)
- 6. Table Service/Serving Etiquette
- 7. Appearance and Interpersonal Skills
- 8. Housekeeping
- 9. Maintenance

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

All potential students must have a minimum of a Grade 10 education, must be 18 years of age or older and must fill out the appropriate application forms and assessments prior to training.

COURSE INFORMATION:

This course will run daily Monday to Friday – 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. – for 6 weeks. Students will be provided with all personal protective equipment (PPE).

EVALUATION:

Students will be evaluated at the end of each section. The instructor will provide an opportunity for improvement based on this feedback. Specific tests will be administered in WHMIS, First Aid, Safe Food Handling and Smart Serve. A customized handwritten test will be completed at the end of the program to determine if competencies are completed. A practical test will also be given in the field to determine if the student can apply these competencies. Students must meet attendance requirements.

CREDENTIALS:

At the successful completion of the program, participants will receive a Confederation College "Recognition of Completion."
