



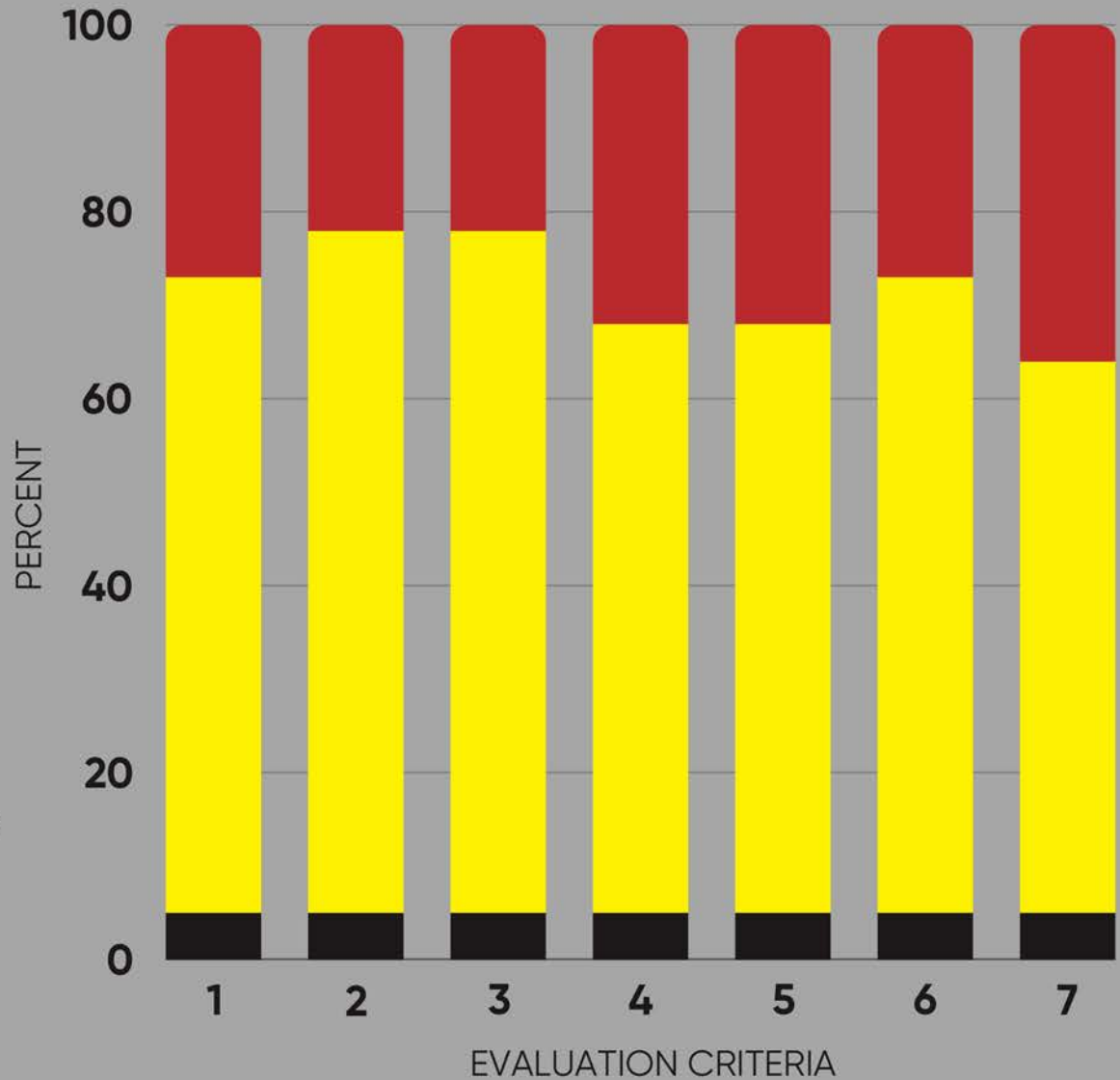

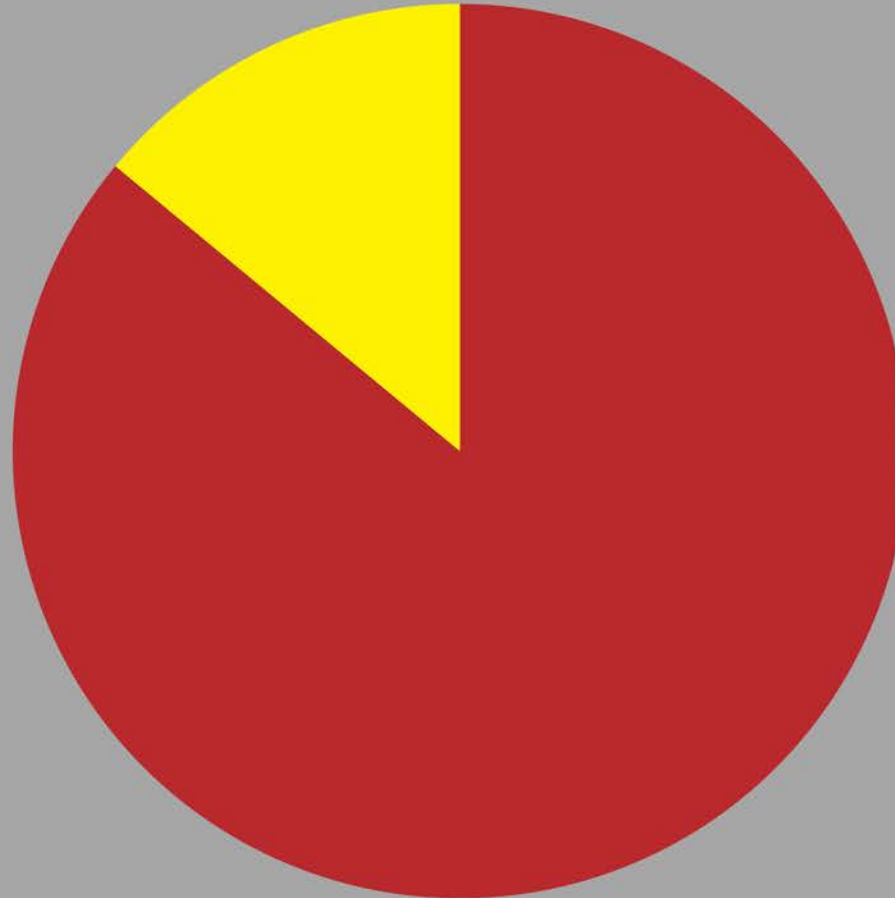
Systems Innovation Focus Group Event Evaluation Criteria
