Anishinabek Employment & Training Services (AETS) in co-operation with its partners, are delivering a Wellness Opportunities Initiative to assess pre-employment, health and treatment needs of eligible First Nation participants living with a disability.

## Eligibility

- AETS First Nation citizens are given priority.
- Must be legally able to work in Canada.
- Living with a disability, which may include developmental, intellectual, physical, mental health, or substance use challenges.

Key outcomes for **individuals** include gaining the tools, skills, and information to obtain employment, become employed or self-employed.

Key outcomes for **employers** include increased ability to hire, retain, and support persons living with a disability in the workplace.
